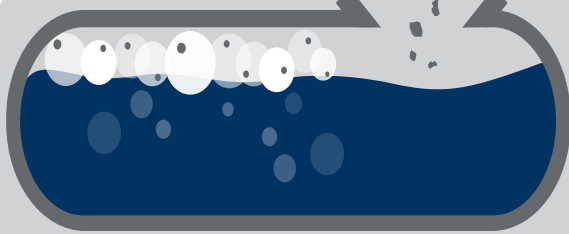


Ore Processing

How it works:

1

A wet grinding process turns the crushed rock into a fine sand.

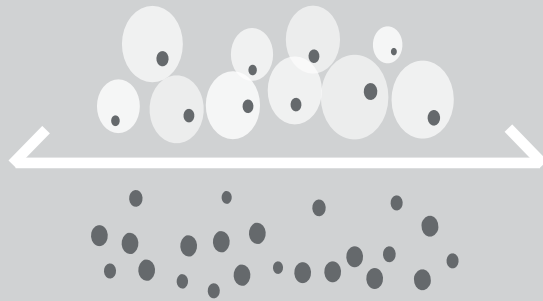


Mixed with water, chemicals and air, the copper minerals attach to bubbles that float to the surface.

Bubbles with copper are skimmed and filtered to produce copper concentrate.



Concentrate is then sent to smelters for further processing.

Smelters convert concentrate into copper cathodes used in the manufacturing of many modern products.
