

#### PROTECTING THE **ENVIRONMENT**

The Emory oak is an important resource to the Western Apache Tribal Nations. The acorns serve as a traditional food source, and the trees hold cultural significance, often being used in tribal ceremonies. In recent decades, Apache elders have noticed the health of these special trees declining. The Emory oak population has also been affected by drought, fire suppression, livestock grazing, groundwater reductions, species competition and climate change.

Resolution Copper is working to protect and preserve this unique species in our community. In the fall of 2018 we began a multi-year partnership with the US Forest Service (USFS), consulting with Western Apache tribes and Northern Arizona University to create the Emory Oak Collaborative Tribal Restorative Initiative (EOCTRI), a conservation program focused solely on restoring the Emory oak habitat. We have been informed and guided by tribal elders' traditional ecological knowledge, and along with essential new academic research funded by Resolution Copper, we are working together to ensure that these special trees are thriving for generations to come.





So far, influenced the project approach, from the relocation of facilities for the protection of specific traditional cultural properties, to the avoidance of medicinal plants, resulted in setting aside more than 800 acres of land and mineral title to protect led to important changes to the project plan. 
