


### **KEEPING OUR WORKFORCE SAFE**

Resolution Copper is committed to a workforce that reflects the local communities and cultures in which we operate and are committed to hiring qualified candidates locally when we can.






### PROTECTING THE ENVIRONMENT **AND OUR COMMUNITY**






## PERMITTING AND CULTURAL HERITAGE
