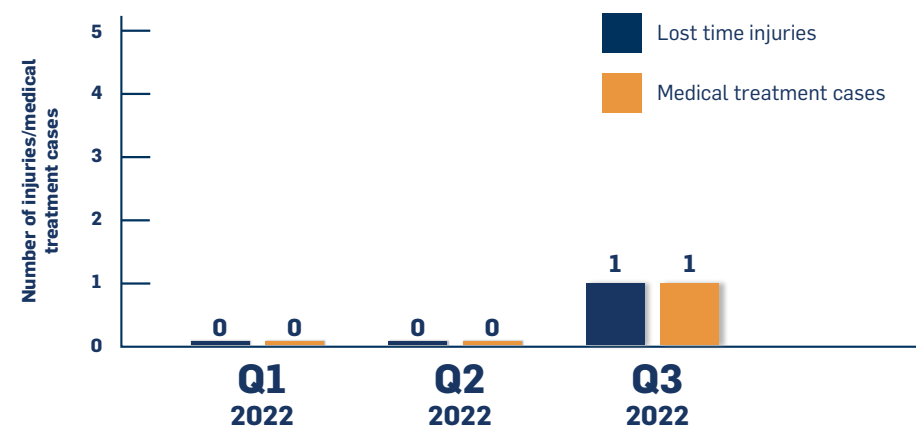


KEEPING OUR WORKFORCE SAFE

At Resolution Copper safety comes first.

One way Resolution measures safety is by the All Injury Frequency Rate (AIFR), which tracks all reportable injuries; lost time injuries, restricted work injuries and medical treatment cases, per 200,000 hours worked.

Resolution Copper closed Q3 2022 with an AIFR of 1.58.

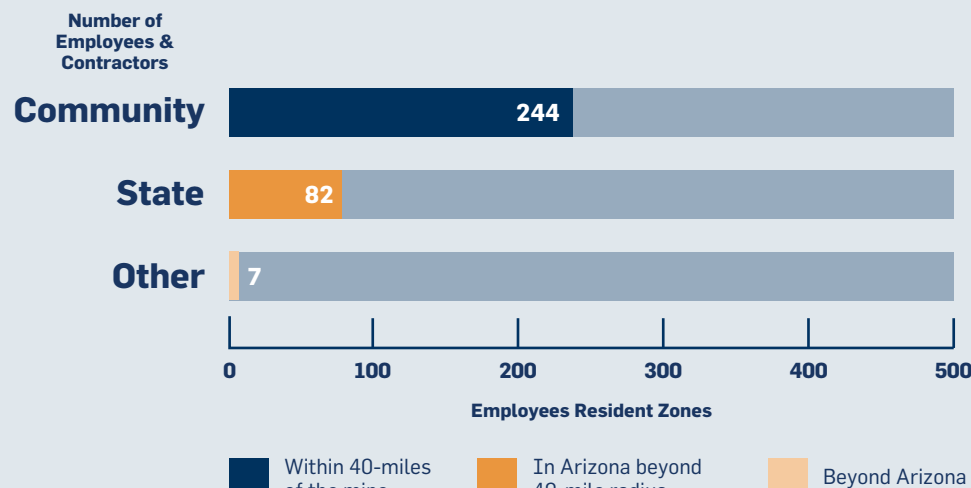

PROTECTING THE ENVIRONMENT AND OUR COMMUNITY

Resolution Copper and its partners recently completed an analysis on the impacts of the Telegraph Fire that burned nearly 200,000 acres of land located south and east of the Town of Superior, including portions of Mineral Creek and Government Springs Ranch. The analysis provided an estimate of the overall impact on habitats for two endangered species occurring on our privately held lands that will be preserved as part of the Environmental Impact Statement: Yellow billed cuckoo and Arizona hedgehog cactus.

We were grateful to see that there was a noticeable change in vegetation growth since the June 2021 fire, likely due to seedling growth supported by post-fire precipitation. Resolution Copper has been monitoring the baseline environmental conditions for over a decade and we are committed to continue supporting the protection of endangered species and special ecosystems.



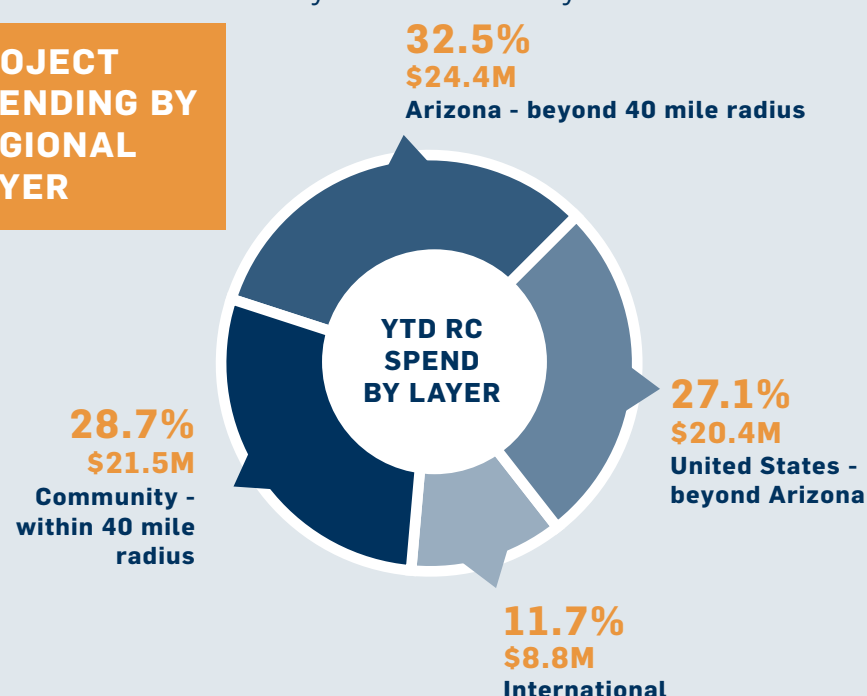

PERMITTING AND CULTURAL HERITAGE

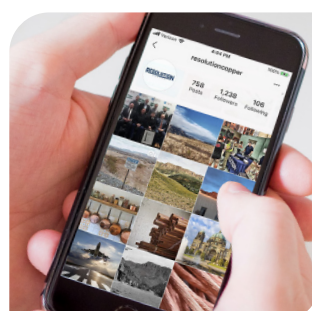
Resolution Copper hosted a week long training on the White Mountain Apache Reservation in conjunction with the Tribe's Forestry Department, WestLand Resources and Northern Arizona University (NAU) to educate high school and college students on Emory Oak data collection methodologies and best practices acquired through the Emory Oak Collaborative Tribal Restoration Initiative (EOCTRI).

The training consisted of site visits to various Oak groves and hands-on data collection activities. It also allowed for tours of ancestral and cultural sites that were identified within the boundaries of the groves. The Emory Oak is of great cultural significance to the Apache people and Resolution Copper is committed to supporting these important legacy projects. The youth of the community play a pivotal role in ensuring the groves are here for future generations.
