#### KEEPING OUR WORKFORCE SAFE

At Resolution Copper, safety comes first. One way Resolution measures safety is by the All Injury Frequency Rate (AIFR), which tracks all reportable injuries; lost time injuries, restricted work injuries and medical treatment cases, per 200,000 hours worked. Resolution Copper closed Q1 2023 with an AIFR of 0.

As science and standards evolve, so do best practices in understanding biodiversity and nature. That's what's driving Resolution Copper to better understand the natural environment around our project and seek ways to further the science behind local and lesser-known plant species that

comprise the biodiversity of the area. To help identify and protect these unique Arizona species, Resolution Copper recently partnered with WestLand Resources, Tonto National Forest, the University of Arizona Herbarium, Desert Survivors Nursery, and many others to put together a new educational paper, "Illustrations of Abutilon and Similar Mallows In Arizona," published in the latest edition of Phytoneuron.

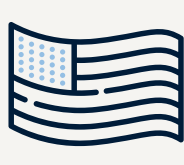
