At Resolution Copper, safety comes first. One way Resolution measures safety is by the All Injury Frequency Rate (AIFR), which tracks all reportable injuries: lost time injuries, restricted work injuries, and medical treatment cases, per 200,000 hours worked.

Minimizing the impact of light & dust from the Resolution Copper operations while maintaining a safe work environment is important to us. To reduce dust, we use a biodegradable product on the roads for dust suppression, which prevents wasteful use of water and reduces dust that could be blown into town. Our Dark Sky Initiative helps mitigate the impact of light from our operation. It is guided by lighting measures in the Pinal County code and Town of Superior zoning ordinance to reduce light pollution, save energy, and reduce impacts on wildlife and ecosystems.


