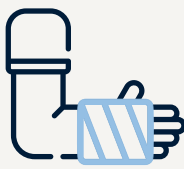
Resolution Copper is committed to creating sustainable benefits for local communities. This scorecard is intended to offer a snapshot of our efforts, including where we need to improve.

KEEPING OUR WORKFORCE SAFE

At Resolution Copper, safety comes first. One way Resolution measures safety is by the All Injury Frequency Rate (AIFR), which tracks all reportable injuries: lost time injuries, restricted work injuries, and medical treatment cases, per 200,000 hours worked.

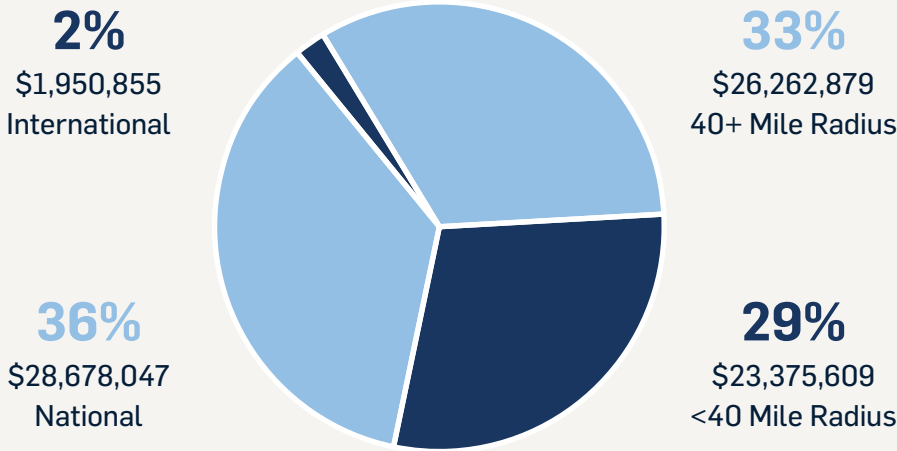
