Our Community Working Group (CWG) includes businesses, area leaders and local organizations interested in the project and committed to the community. In addition, CWG performs community water quality sampling alongside Resolution Copper.

Since 2016, Resolution Copper has contributed nearly \$20 million to over **300 local initiatives**, spanning education, environment, community development, arts and culture.

We offer an annual scholarship program that provides financial assistance to local students pursuing higher education while also encouraging students to explore career opportunities in the mining industry and related STEM fields.

At Central Arizona College we established a 3-year apprenticeship program that allows college students to develop the skills required to safely operate and maintain assets on-site.
